I like being a mathematician:

- Think about how long ago the Stone Age was, create a timeline of humans on Earth.
- Continue to practice times tables.
- Research the height of Stone Age monuments like the Stonehenge.

I like being creative:

Create a Stone Age wall painting. It must tell the story of your tribe (handprints, paw prints, food you eat etc.)

Create or design a Stone Age tool that might have been useful to an early man.

Create a menu fit for an early human. Think about what they might have hunted or foraged.

I like being a scientist:

- Research the creator of the lightbulb, Nicola Tesla and Thomas Edison. List the other things that they invented and how some of them work.
- Create a shadow puppet, make up a story to go with your puppets.

I like being a reader, a writer and being creative with words:

- Read a story from the library set in the Stone Age.
- Write a review about a film or book that is set the Stone Age. (Stone Age Boy, Early Man, Horrible Histories).
- Write a diary extract on a day in the life of a Stone Age person.

I like being an active learner:

- Go on a Stone Age walk, forage for things in the park. (Don't eat anything you find!)
- Sketch your shadow and 3 different times during the day. Has it moved?
- Build a den or shelter made out of mammoth skins!
