### **Mission Statement**

### **Uniform**

Children should endeavour to wear the St Joseph's uniform.

The uniform that should be worn in school time at St Joseph's is as follows:

Royal blue cardigan/jumper/sweatshirt (with or without logo)

White blouse/shirt/polo shirt

Dark grey skirt/pinafore dress/trousers

Summer: Blue gingham dress/grey shorts

Boys- black or grey socks, girls- white knee or ankle socks/grey tights

Black shoes (not trainers).

PE: White T-shirt, blue shorts, black pumps (indoor), trainers (outdoor). In Key Stage 2, children should also bring tracksuit pants, a t-shirt and a sweatshirt top for outdoor activities. All PE kits to be in a labelled PE bag.

Other: No jewellery (except a wrist watch with no internet/Bluetooth use), plain studded earrings allowed (to be covered during sports sessions), all hair tied back, no extreme, patterned or dyed hair cuts.

All children need a school book bag- no rucksacks allowed due to limited space in cloakroom.

All uniform is to be clearly labelled; any lost non-labelled uniform will be placed in lost property.

The school will not unlawfully discriminate against any person on the basis of their ethnicity.
