Gather craft materials to create your own 3D mountain. Can you decorate and paint this?

Research famous paintings of mountains and recreate these using a similar style of art and materials.

What animals live in mountainous areas? Can you draw and colour in one of these for our class display?

I like being scientific:

Listen to the sounds around you. Can you hear sounds of different pitches and volumes? Record these sounds in a diagram.

How does sound travel? Can you make some string telephones to help sound travel over a distance?

Can we see soundwaves? Investigate how you can capture sound waves (hint- you can use rice or water)

I like learning outside:

Visit a local hill or mountainous area. What wildlife can you see there? Does the type of plant found there change as you get to a higher altitude?

Use natural materials to create your own 3D mountain and take photos of your creation. Can you label the parts of the mountain?

Can you see any flowers begin to grow? Draw a picture of what you can see.
